The Evolution of On Location: MEMPHIS From Film Festival to Cinematic Ecosystem



Introduction:

In the dynamic landscape of Memphis, a city deeply rooted in cultural richness, the evolution of On Location: MEMPHIS from its origins as the Memphis Film Forum to its present-day status as a thriving cinematic ecosystem is a testament to the vision and dedication of its leaders. This article explores the remarkable journey of On Location: MEMPHIS, highlighting its transformative initiatives under the leadership of Attorney Angela Green and its role in nurturing the film and music industry within the vibrant city of Memphis.

The Birth and Growth of On Location: MEMPHIS:

Founded by Michael C. Harwood, the Memphis Film Forum laid the foundation for what would later become the International Film & Music Festival—a celebration that went beyond traditional screenings. The first step involved pausing the traditional film festival and collaborating with organizations like Historical Clayborn (formerly-known-as Clayborn Reborn) to produce small screening events, expanding the organization's impact within the community.

The Birth of Innovative Programs:

evolution of On The Location: MEMPHIS gave rise to groundbreaking programs designed to empower local artists and filmmakers. The Memphis Music Bang (MMB), a music licensing website, provides a doorway into the world of music licensing and scoring for music artists that manage their publishing. It also provides indie filmmakers with affordable original music for their films. The Auteur Club. an online network, provides access to sample forms / agreements, legal







information, DIY educational / training videos and business consulting, while Memphis Movie Production (MMP) provides below-the-line job training classes and valuable production jobs on short film projects, to help deepen the production talent pool in Shelby County, TN.

Impact on the Local Creative Community:

The impact of these programs has been profound, as artists and filmmakers in Memphis now have the tools and resources

needed to run successful businesses without leaving their community. On Location: MEMPHIS has become a cornerstone for legal information, business consulting, digital distribution channels, and job training, empowering artists to thrive locally.

A Thriving Cinematic Ecosystem:

On Location: MEMPHIS has successfully transformed into a cinematic ecosystem that nurtures the growth of the film and music industry in Memphis. Through innovative programs, it has created opportunities for artists to showcase their talent, learn essential business skills, and connect with industry professionals. Memphis is now a city where artists can build successful careers, contributing to the vibrant cultural landscape without having to leave home.


Kevin Khachan



He studied film at SAE Film School then later achieved a Masters Degree in film production from Sydney University, Kevin is currently completing a thesis on Frankenmedia: "Frankenstein and the multimodality of the slasher". He attracted international attention with his very first feature, Red Rabbit Lodge. A highly creative and award winning director Kevin has often been descried as a young Dario Argento. Kevin then traveled to Prague Czech Republic to shoot his second feature film one that he wrote and directed Remnants set to hit the festival circuit late (2021). In addition to this he has written and directed Box Metaphor (2022) along with directing True Love (2023) pilot. Kevin will also be directing a documentary for National Geographic, Botanical Adventures (2021).

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
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"Steel Will" - short cyberpunk (sci-fi) boxing drama movie, written and directed by EUGENE KHAZIN. Story set in not-so-far future - 10-30 years. Film tells about professional boxing champion - Robert Steel "Hammer" - who lost his arm and got replacement with robotic prosthetic. Movie focuses on his struggles in the boxing ring under new conditions, relationships with his loved ones and Robert's inner tight with himself.

Apart from being already cult following and internationally award winning project, it was done as a proof of concept, based on selected scenes and characters from full feature script "Steel Will", authored by E.Khazin. Up to this date it is first ever live-action movie, that combines both boxing drama and cyberpunk in one story. As Lift-Off Film Festival noted: "Steel Will is a fun, unique idea that is well executed with authentic location work and handmade practical effects that allow the film to have a bit of fun basking in its premise".

Director and writer of "Steel Will", EUGENE KHAZIN, comes from mixed minority background of Ukrainian-Jewish, now living in LA, USA. Directing films for about 7 years, he has more than 15 successfully finished projects, among others created series of videos for Olympic boxing champion – Taras Shelestyuk. Eugene is a holder of several awards, including "Best Director", focuses mainly on science-fiction and fantasy genres.

"Steel Will" gathered talented and recognizable people. Main hero Robert Steel was portrayed by SEAN FERGUSON, female lead – Robert's wife Penelope – by OKSANA PLATERO (star of "Dancing with the Stars" and "Motown with a twist"); supporting role of trainer Harley was done by one of producers – MARK HERON. Both executive producers hail from Ukraine – VOLODYMUR PANCHUK and VADYM BELOZOROV.

Editing was performed by MARC COHEN - who previously was nominated for Emmy Awards, received several "Best Editor" . Musical soundtrack was written and performed by CHRIS WIRSIG - holder of couple "Best Musical score" awards.



Currently, team of "Steel Will" in talks and looking for potential investors and producers to bring this one-of-a-kind script to big screens, to tell this whole exciting and unique story with very original approach to cinematography and storytelling.





















A girl explores multiple ways of closing the door to save their first relationship crisis.

2049+ Voice of Rebirth






















BUCKE HEAD

In her later life, an old lady with hearing impairment and mobility difficulties faced family disturbances and inconveniences in life. Even if she cannot participate in the outside world, she still has a subjective choice of how she communicates with the world.



The story told through the cinematographic eye of Svetlana Cemin

Creativity, passion and the brilliant mind of those who dedicate themselves to cinema are important factors that lead to the realization of a good production.

The film director, for example, may be anywhere in the world, at the wrong place or time perhaps, and from there one of the best stories may emerge that will drive him to materialize his next feature film, documentary or project.

Such is the case of Svetlana Cemin, who is originally from Belgrade, Serbia and who has worked as a writer, director, producer and founder of 610FILM, an auteur film production company.

Film Director Svetlana Cemin

Before becoming an award-winning filmmaker, she worked as an internationally renowned fashion model and actress. She appeared in numerous off-Broadway productions and in several films, including Lodge Kerrigan's Claire Dolan, which premiered at the Cannes Film Festival.

For Svetlana Cemin and her keen eye as a filmmaker led her to create Monk Arsenije, precisely in one of the unimaginable situations whose experience made her idealize the documentary

Since its screening, Monk Arsenije, which 52 lasts minutes, has received innumerable awards at different film festivals and in major categories such as Winner Best Film at Serbfest SIFF Moldavia 2021, Winner Best Feature Documentary in Hollywood at the Tiber Awards 2021, Winner Experimental Film at the London Movie 2022, Silver Award Best Documentary at the Hollywood Gold Awards 2022 and Honorable Mention at Paris Film Awards 2022, to name a few.

In addition, due to the great acceptance and recognition, it will be distributed through Screenbound International Pictures Ltd. and on Amazon Prime UK and other partners such as Beldocs, the film has a three-year distribution agreement on TV Insider in southern Europe.

But who is Monk Arsenije and how did it all start? Monk Arsenije is a cult figure from Belgrade from the 1980s who has lived as a monk for the last 30 years, now over the years he is dedicated to restoring and creating a spiritual and cultural center in the Ribnica Monastery in central Serbia.

The film Monk Arsenije was a project that arose spontaneously, without any previous concept of planning. It was in June 2018, when Svetlana Cemin and her team were finishing the last days of shooting the documentary Saint Clair Cemin, Psyche. According to Cemin, she received a phone call from an old friend, Aleksandar Jovanovic, who now calls himself Arsenije, since he became an Orthodox monk. Arsenije, absent for twenty-seven years, came to New York City to promote his book God and Rock'n'roll and the phone call was to invite the film director to a conference he was giving at the Greek Orthodox Church in Chelsea. conversation became so lively that Arsenije was invited by Cemin to his 610 FILM studio in Brooklyn, as his story made her curious about the change he had made by practicing Christianity, to the point of living as a hermit for several years on a mountain near Albania. After spending the whole day listening to his fascinating story, Cemin asked if he could film his next lecture. At first Arsenije seemed puzzled but then he nodded and so it all began. After the first day of filming in Manhattan, the director knew she had to make a cinematic portrait of him and the rest is history.



But while the "democratic world" was aggressively indifferent to the life of the people of Donbass, a wave of empathy has now broken out. It is not bad, on the contrary, however, there remains a bad taste of double standards. This large-scale war had to be stopped in its infancy, but apparently the interest in its expansion was too strong. We are the people, who have been fighting for peace within last eight years, now it's your turn – think about your responsibility and do not believe everything that the mainstream media expose to you.

60 min. documentary, Bulgaria


"The Donbass Children" is a film about the war in Eastern Ukraine. This war, which has been going on for eight years now, although the mass media are trying to convince us that it has been started in February this year. In this film the audience will get to know the stories of ordinary people of Donbass, victims of insane military tactics – unprovoked shelling of residential areas. Common people will also uncover their attitude to this war.

The film was completed in 2019. The authors aimed to draw attention to this armed conflict in the heart of Europe and to make the viewer reflect on our shared responsibility for peace on the continent and in the world as well as for the deafening silence about the crimes and terrorism of the authorities against people, who are in no way involved in this conflict, and on the strange neglection and even encouragement of crime by the so-called democratic and civilized world.















The Human Trial - Would you go first?

In 2011, Lisa Hepner and her husband Guy Mossman heard about a radical stem cell treatment for diabetes, a disease that shockingly kills more than five million people each year. Driven by a desire to cure Lisa of her own type 1 diabetes (T1D), the filmmakers were given unprecedented, real-time access to a clinical trial -- only the sixth-ever embryonic stem cell trial in the world. What follows is an intimate decade-long journey with the patients and scientists who put themselves on the line to be first.







An old man and his granddaughter make their way home after spending the day together, encountering a seemingly unimportant homeless man (Heads) en route to the bus stop. In a moment of distraction, someone takes his granddaughter. All possible witnesses leave on a bus and in a state of panic the old man reverts to asking Heads, whom he previously dejected. Heads is reluctant at first but ultimately decides to help find the girl.

It is revealed to the old man as they make their way through the city that Heads has a particular ability, something that should be impossible. With a glance, Heads can see into others' past perspectives. Each dive leads the team closer to where the girl went. Eventually, though, it seems there are no other witnesses available and the trail runs dry, but there is still hope.

Heads was a man broken, finished with a life that tore him down and left him alone. But in the end, he finds a reason to get up and fight again.

Graduating from the faculty of medicine, he later specialised in radiology. For the last 30 years as a radiologist, he has taken images of human's insides. In fact, those expensive medical imaging devices, such as MR and CT are not so different from cameras. One of the main differences is that medical equipment generally take crosssectioned images of people and show insides of bodies, whereas cameras show us their exteriors. Bayar tries to use other than usual meanings of the images. "So, I also have attempted to show the talkfree aspect of the world."

Images and music were entirely created with artificial intelligence, only the script being "human". No 3D is involved, just Al.




THE HARRISVILLE HAUNTING: THE REAL CONJURING HOUSE
